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

Located in Via Andegari 9 at the crossroads of the artistic quarter of Brera, the Fashion District and the financial centre, Mandarin Oriental, Milan is a luxury hotel that provides warm Milanese hospitality. 

LYING AT THE HEART OF MILAN, THE CITY CENTER IS PACKED WITH SIGHTS. NOT TO BE MISSED IS THE CITY'S GLAMOROUS FASHION DISTRICT.

At the heart of the historical centre lies the awe-inspiring Gothic Duomo, the symbol of the city, while the sumptuous Galleria Vittorio Emanuele II nearby is lined with elegant boutiques and fine dining restaurants. The historic Sforza Castle, the ancient seat of the ruling Visconti, is replete with history, while Milan's famous *La Scala Opera House*, where Verdi and Puccini premiered their operas, is today

one of the city's main attractions for opera and ballet performances. Fashion lovers must not miss the city's Fashion District, which is an attraction in its own right. Lined with haute couture fashion houses, its pretty cobbled streets are well worth a wander. In the early evenings, the city's bars and cafes are abuzz with custom, as locals head out to enjoy their much-loved *aperitivo*, a pre-dinner drink said to stimulate the appetite.

Commissioned by Maria Theresa of Austria and inaugurated in 1778, La Scala is one of the world's most prestigious opera houses, hosting classical music, ballet and opera performances. Some of the greatest Italian operas were premiered here, including Bellini's Norma and Verdi's Otello.





Hidden Citv CRYPT OF SAN SEPOLCRO

In 2016, the Crypt of San Sepolcro reopened to the public after 50 years. Built in the 11th century on the site of what was the heart of the Roman city, the crypt has flooring made of large slabs of Verona stone that were once part of the ancient Roman forum. Cardinal Borromeo defined the crypt as the city's 'belly button', while Leonardo da Vinci considered it to be the true heart of Milan, as depicted in one of his maps in the Codex Atlanticus.

Inaugurated in 1915 by Davide Campari, this legendary venue is renowned for its Milanese aperitivo. Interiors were entirely refurbished and redesigned by architecture firm Lissoni Associati who redefined its identity while also preserving and honouring its heritage and Art Nouveau décor. Open from breakfast until late, it offers innovative dishes and an exciting drinks list featuring a unique blend of Signature cocktails and creative drinks.



BRERA

ONE OF MILAN'S MOST ATMOSPHERIC DISTRICTS, BRERA IS THE CITY'S ARTISTIC QUARTER, CHARACTERISED BY PRETTY COBBLED STREETS. HOME TO ARTISTS' WORKSHOPS AND INDEPENDENT BOUTIQUES, IT HAS A DISTINCTLY BOHEMIAN AIR.

With its cobblestone streets, floweradorned balconies and secret courtyards, Brera is an elegant timeless district harbouring some of the city's best cultural attractions. The Pinacoteca di Brera houses one of Italy's most comprehensive collections of Italian art, while the nearby Botanical Garden is a pleasant spot for a stroll. Scores of lively cafes and restaurants are dotted here and there throughout

the neighbourhood. Since the 19th century, Brera has been the artistic district of the city, with a particularly lively, bustling atmosphere around the *Accademia delle Belle Arti*. Many of the area's buildings were commissioned by Maria Theresa of Austria, who transformed *Palazzo di Brera* into a veritable cultural centre. The building houses the *Accademia*, the *Pinacoteca* and the Lombard

Institute Academy of Science and Letters, as well as the Braidense National Library, the Astronomical Observatory and the Botanical Garden. On the third Sunday of the month, Brera hosts a lively flea market, while during the annual Fuorisalone, Brera is considered to be Milan's leading design district, hosting numerous exhibitions and design events that attract large crowds.

Founded by Maria Theresa of Austria in 1775, Brera's Botanical Garden is a quiet verdant oasis in Milan's bustling city centre. Originally created as an educational centre, the garden was enriched with a number of exotic plants, many of which were added during the Napoleonic era. The garden aims to safeguard biodiversity and protect rare species. In 2005, the region of Lombardy officially recognised it as a museum.

Home to one of the country's leading collections of Italian paintings, the *Pinacoteca di Brera* displays masterpieces spanning from the 13th to the 20th century. Originally set up in 1776 to display works for students of the adjacent *Accademia di Belle Arti*, the Pinacoteca was officially founded as an art gallery in 1809 to store works looted from French-occupied Italy during the reign of Napoleone Bonaparte.





Hidden City Q CONCA DELL'INCORONATA

Officially recognised as a monument, the *Conca dell'Incoronata* is all that remains of the *Naviglio Martesana* within the city's old Spanish walls. Built in 1496 during the time of Duke Ludovico il Moro, this historic lock was studied by Leonardo Da Vinci. It was once known as *Conca delle Gabelle*, as it was here that people were required to pay 'gabelle', taxes on goods and people.

Bistro and cocktail bar, Tibi is a charming romantic corner of Provence offering an intimate ambience. 

Porta Venezia is one of Milan's liveliest and most sought-after districts, with iconic Art Nouveau architecture, outstanding art galleries, extensive green spaces, excellent shopping, quirky eateries, gourmet restaurants and bustling nightlife venues offering expertly crafted cocktails. This unique district is also rich in history, home to the Casa Cambiaghi, Palazzo and Torre Rasini, Piscina Cozzi, the Casa di Vico Magistretti and Torre di

Breda, a 116-metre high building with 31 floors that is taller than the city's iconic Madonnina del Duomo statue. It's also home to Palazzo Luraschi, which occupies a section of the famous Lazzaretto, the city's former leper hospital. The building pays homage to Alessandro Manzoni's The Bethrothed, with twelve busts in the courtyard depicting the novel's main characters. Not to be missed are the wonderful Neoclassical Villa Reale and Villa Necchi Campiglio, a noble Milanese residence designed by Italian architect Piero Portaluppi. The area is also home to the Casa Museo Boschi di Stefano, the GAM Modern Art Gallery, PAC Contemporary Art Pavilion, Villa Invernizzi – whose gardens are home to beautiful pink flamingos – and the secluded Indro Montanelli gardens, one of the city's green lungs. With so much to see and do, the district is well worth a visit.



ISOLA, PORTA NUOVA, GARIBALDI & MONUMENTALE

ONE OF THE CITY'S TRENDIEST AND MOST ENERGETIC DISTRICTS, ISOLA FULLY EMBODIES CONTEMPORARY MILAN, WHERE THE LATEST FOOD, FASHION AND DESIGN TRENDS THRIVE AND EVOLVE.

This former industrial area in northern Milan takes its name from a time when it was separated from the rest of the city, isolated by railway lines. Today, Isola is a vibrant up-and-coming district that has maintained its roots as a working-class area. The district was revamped as part of a modernisation project that started in 2009 and included nearby *Porta Garibaldi* and *Porta Nuova*. It's home to traditional *trattorie*, trendy cafés, cocktail bars, elegant boutiques and

vintage shops. Biking aficionados flock here to enjoy Europe's first moto-district, an entire street dedicated to motorbikes, with garages, shops, bars, motorcycles and themed events taking place year-round. With its mesmerizing eco-sustainable wall fountains and solar panels, *Piazza Gae Aulenti* epitomises Milan's contemporary urban landscape and stands at the foot of the tallest building in Italy, the *Unicredit Tower*. The district's most famous building is probably the Bosco Verticale (Vertical Forest), a telling example of urban reforestation and architecture that supports native biodiversity. The project was thought up by Boeri Studio, and has today become a symbol of Milan, with two residential towers home to roughly 1000 different plant species. A short walk from the Centro Direzionale business district is the Monumental Cemetery, a fascinating open-air museum with impressive sculptures and intricately decorated tombs.

A tribute to the life of those who have played a key role in Milan's history, the Monumental Cemetery is a fascinating open-air museum that extends over 250 thousand square metres. It contains the tombs of some of Italy's most eminent citizens, including novelists Alessandro Manzoni and Salvatore Quasimodo, and is the burial place of influential families from the industrial bourgeoisie, such as the Bocconi, Campari, Falck, Branca and Treccani families, to mention a few.

Donato Bramante and Leonardo da Vinci both left a mark on Magenta, a district that is beautifully rich in art and history, attracting thousands of visitors every year. These two Italian geniuses came together and gave life to numerous masterpieces, including the Convento di Santa Maria delle Grazie, considered to be one of Italy's most spectacular sights. A designated Unesco World Heritage Site since 1980, the church houses The Last Supper, while a stone's throw away are the Casa degli

Atellani and La Vigna di Leonardo museums. The district is also home to the Basilica di Sant'Ambrogio, an Early Christian and medieval monument that is one of Milan's oldest churches. 

Once a city on water with navigable canals, Milan preserves traces of its past, with the popular Naviglio Grande and Naviglio Pavese located by the Darsena, Milan's old harbour that was redeveloped for Expo 2015. The area is perfect for a Sunday stroll, especially on the last Sunday of the month when it hosts the lively Mercatone dell'Antiquariato (antiques market). The charming Navigli (canals) are renowned for their vibrant nightlife, with a wide range of exclusive bars and eateries open throughout the day

and night. Connecting the Basilica di San Lorenzo and Porta Ticinese. Corso Ticinese is an eclectic street lined with independent shops and ethnic restaurants. 

THIS WELCOMING RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT ACTIVELY PROMOTES A RANGE OF INTERESTING CULTURAL ACTIVITIES, SETTING NEW TRENDS WHILE HONOURING HISTORY AND TRADITION.

Formerly a quiet residential area, the lively district of *Porta Romana* is a gastronomic hub, with restaurants buzzing with life and tables spilling out onto the pavements in summer. *Porta Romana* once provided access to the city of Milan and it was here that the road leading to Rome began (hence its name). Today, it teems with students from the nearby *Università Bocconi*, while its friendly atmosphere attracts a fair share of families. The district offers plenty of activities, from enjoying a

sauna at QC Terme while soaking up views of the ancient Roman aqueduct to enjoying a swim at the Bagni Misteriosi (Mysterious Baths), which becomes a lovely ice-skating rink in winter. Not to be missed is the avant-garde Fondazione Prada, with a range of exhibition spaces and an excellent restaurant offering striking views of the city skyline. Porta Romana is also home to the Teatro Franco Parenti and the Cinemino, a small and hip 74-seat cinema with a warm and cosy café.

SANTA MARIA DELLE GRAZIE And the last supper

One of Milan's most recognisable landmarks, the Basilica of Santa Maria delle Grazie is an exquisite Renaissance jewel giving onto a pretty square. Designed by Guiniforte Solari, this church complex and Dominican convent dates back to 1463. It was reworked and enlarged at the end of the 15th century by renowned Renaissance architect Donato Bramante, who added a refectory, a drum-shaped dome, large apses and the graceful *Chiostro delle Rane*. Commissioned by Ludovico Sforza, Duke of Milan, The Last Supper was painted between 1494 and 1497 on the refectory walls. While much of the original is sadly lost, the painting has gone through painstaking restoration processes over the course of the years to preserve as much of the original composition as possible. The Last Supper is today one of the world's most recognisable works of art. DUOMO

SFORZA CASTLE

Tucked away in Parco Sempione, the Sforza Castle was the defining symbol of power and influence of the ruling Visconti family. Today, the castle harmoniously combines art and history, with scores of events and activities regularly taking place in its ancient halls. The castle houses a number of museums, as well as the wonderful Sala delle Asse, which is adorned with frescoes by Leonardo Da Vinci. Along with a selection of paintings by Andrea Mantegna, the castle museums display a number of exquisite artworks, including Michelangelo's Pietà Rondanini and Bramantino's Ciclo Trivulzio tapestries.



BASILICA DI Sant'Ambrogio

Commissioned by the Bishop of Milan, the majestic *Basilica di* Sant'Ambrogio is one of the most ancient examples of Romanesque architecture in Milan. Erected in the heart of the historic centre between 379 and 386, the *Basilica* features a large crypt housing the remains of Saint Ambrogio.

The lavish *Galleria Vittorio Emanuele II* is home to the city's most iconic shops, restaurants and cafes. Nicknamed 'il salotto di Milano' (Milan's drawing room), this elegant shopping arcade lies steps away from the *Duomo* and *La Scala Opera House*. Embellished with beautiful frescoes, it has a central octagon-shaped space topped with a magnificent glass dome. The Galleria is famous for its tiled mosaic floor depicting a bull, said to bring luck and increased fertility.

PALAZZO REALE

Once Milan's seat of government and the former residence of the Visconti and Sforza families, the Royal Palace harmoniously blends art and history. The palace is today a lively cultural centre, with groundbreaking art exhibitions hosted in its lavish rooms and halls.



CHURCH OF SAN MAURIZIO AL MONASTERO MAGGIORE

Hidden away among the elegant buildings of the historic centre, the Church of San Maurizio al Monastero Maggiore was built in 1503 adjacent to a female Benedictine convent (which today houses Milan's Archaeological Museum). Nicknamed 'Milan's Sistine Chapel', the church is embellished with magnificent frescoes by Bernardino Luini and painters of the Lombard school of art. featuring elaborate depictions of saints, parables and scenes from the Bible.



L.O.V.E. -PIAZZA AFFARI

Piazza degli Affari

In 2010, a large sculpture created by controversial artist Maurizio Cattelan was placed in front of Palazzo Mezzanotte, the seat of Milan's stock exchange. L.O.V.E.. which stands for freedom, hate, revenge and eternity in Italian, features a huge hand with a towering middle finger. Given its location, the statue seems to send a clear message to the Milan stock market and the financial world in general, although the artist has denied this. The artwork continues to divide the city.





BASILICA **DI SAN BABILA**

The red-brick façade of the Basilica di San Babila stands out among the buildings of the eponymous square. A Catholic place of worship and the city's first Christian church, it is considered a Neo-Romanesque landmark thanks to the restoration project that architect Paolo Cesa Bianchi began in 1880. The pipe organ is still used during liturgical ceremonies.





CHURCH OF SANTA MARIA PRESSO SAN SATIRO

Tucked away on a quiet street off bustling Via Torino, the small Church of Santa Maria presso San Satiro is an artistic and architectural masterpiece. In order to create the illusion of depth, Italian architect Donato Bramante created an ingenious trompe l'oeil by painting the back wall to give the appearance of a barrel-vaulted choir with a coffered ceiling.

PALAZZO DELLA RAGIONE AND PIAZZA DEI MERCANTI

A hub of political and commercial activity during the medieval times, *Piazza Mercanti* is a wonderfully picturesque square that preserves an authentic medieval atmosphere. Among the square's most striking buildings is the 13th century *Palazzo* della Ragione, which played an important role in public life until the end of the 18th century.

Theresa of Austria, Milan's La Scala Opera House is one of the world's most famous theatres, hosting concerts, theatre, opera

and ballet performances. Many leading Italian operas were staged here, including Verdi's Nabucco and Puccini's Madame Butterfly. The theatre's opulent U-shaped auditorium is adorned with giltedged boxes, velvet fittings and a large glittering crystal chandelier.

THE BASILICA AND Columns of San Lorenzo

One of the city's oldest churches, the *Basilica di San Lorenzo* was founded in the fourth century, built using masonry from a number of Roman buildings. Standing near the church are sixteen Corinthian columns, ancient Roman ruins that are thought to have once been part of a Roman bathing complex. The church houses a large organ that is still used during ceremonies.



TORRE VELASCA

An iconic Milanese landmark, the 26-storey *Torre Velasca* was Milan's first skyscraper. Housing both public spaces and private apartments, the mushroomshaped building was built in the 1950s by the *BBPR* architectural partnership. A tribute to Milan's brutalist architecture, the building was designed to be a modern reinterpretation of the *Sforza Castle's Filarete Tower*.

BASILICA DI SANT'EUSTORGIO Piazza Sant'Eustorgio, 1

It is thought that the city's first Christians were baptised at the ancient font of this basilica, which was built in the fourth century to house the bones of the Three Kings. The church was later destroyed by Frederick Barbarossa, who stole the relics and took them to Cologne's cathedral. Some of the bones were returned in the early 20th century, and are kept in a reliquary above the altar.





ROTONDA DELLA BESANA

A former cemetery, the *Rotonda della Besana* is a late Baroque building complex with a colonnaded portico and a garden housing the small deconsecrated *Church of San Michele*, which is today home to the Milan Children's Museum (MUBA). One of the city's most unusual sites, the *Rotonda della Besana* is a haven of peace, offering a quiet spot to enjoy a peaceful stroll.



ARCO DELLA PACE AND PARCO SEMPIONE

Piazza Sempione

Inaugurated in 1837, Milan's Arco della Pace (triumphal arch) is located at the beginning of Corso Sempione. Built in white marble and bronze, it is today one of the city's most important neoclassical monuments. In June 1859, Napoleon III and Vittorio Emanuele II made a triumphant entrance through the arch to a jubilant Milanese crowd. The arch is located by Parco Sempione, one of the city's most attractive green spaces.



PINACOTECA AMBROSIANA

Established in 1618 by Cardinal Federico Borromeo when he donated his prestigious collection of statues, paintings and drawings to the Ambrosian Library, the *Pinacoteca Ambrosiana* proudly boasts one of the world's greatest collections of art. Its twenty-four rooms display masterpieces from the Renaissance to the 20th century, with works by Da Vinci, Caravaggio, Botticelli, Tiepolo and Hayez, among others.





CHIARAVALLE ABBEY


Tucked away in the southern outskirts of Milan, the Chiaravalle Abbey was commissioned by San Bernardo di Chiaravalle, a member of the Order of Cistercians. Founded in 1135, the abbey is one of the earliest examples of Gothic architecture, with beautifully frescoed cloisters and a striking terracotta and marble tower, known as the Ciribiciaccola. The grounds also house the 15th century Cappella di San Bernardo, a chapel reserved only for women. A small hamlet developed around the abbey, and has been inhabited ever since.

CHURCH OF SANTA Maria del carmine

Characterised by a striking terracotta facade, the *Church of Santa Maria del Carmine* is a historic landmark in the heart of Brera. A wonderful example of Lombardy's Neo-Gothic architecture, it was built on the ruins of the 13th century *Chiesa Carmelitana* and eventually completed in 1880 by architect Carlo Maciachini.

MUSEUMS & PERMANENT COLLECTIONS

MUSEO DEL NOVECENTO

Opened in 2010 in the *Palazzo dell'Arengario*, the *Museo del Novecento* houses a wonderful collection of contemporary art. A futuristic spiral ramp connects the floors of the museum, offering breathtaking views of the *Duomo's* terraces. The gallery hosts regular temporary exhibitions along with activities and events that promote the rich cultural and artistic heritage of the 20th century. Not to be missed is Lucio Fontana's famous Neon Structure of 1951. Visitors can browse a selection of titles at the museum's charming bookshop, while the elegant third floor Giacomo Arengario Restaurant, featuring cosy artdeco style interiors, makes for the perfect setting for a convivial meal.





ARMANI/SILOS

Opened in 2015, Armani/Silos is an exhibition space that celebrates Giorgio Armani's career. Housed in a former granary, this wonderful museum showcases some of the brand's most iconic fashion pieces. Three themed floors – Androgino, Etnie and Stars – shed light on the designer's sublime creations. There's also a digital archive, as well as a gift shop, café and exhibition space displaying temporary collections.

GALLERIE D'ITALIA

Overlooking *Piazza della Scala*, the *Gallerie d'Italia* are housed in a wonderful neoclassical palazzo that was formerly a bank, the *Banca Commerciale Italiana*. The gallery displays a superb collection of art, with works spanning from the end of the 18th century to the early 20th century.

VILLA NECCHI CAMPIGLIO

Surrounded by a beautiful garden with swimming pool, Villa Necchi Campiglio was built in the early 1930s by architect Piero Portaluppi for a wealthy Milanese industrialist. A wonderful example of Art Deco, the villa sheds light on the life of the city's privileged bourgeoisie in the first half of the 20th century. In 2001, sisters Gigina Nedda Campiglio and Nedda Necchi donated the villa to Italy's FAI, a non-profit organisation that aims to protect Italy's cultural heritage. This gorgeous villa was finally opened to the public, allowing visitors to admire its wonderful Art Deco interiors and works of art.



As well as Oriental art, there are works by major Italian artists and sculptors such as Giorgio Morandi, Francesco Hayez and Giovanni Segantini, as well as paintings by Van Gogh, Matisse and Picasso. The gallery regularly hosts temporary exhibitions.

CIVIC MUSEUM -Sforza castle

Housed in the *Sforza Castle*, the *Civic Museums* display a wide range of exhibits, including paintings, objets d'art, sculptures, pottery, musical instruments, books and archaeological collections that shed light on Milan's history. This historic venue is home to the *Museo d'Arte Antica* (Museum of Ancient Art), the *Biblioteca d'Arte* (Art Library) and the *Museo Pietà Rondanini*, which houses the *Pietà*, Michelangelo's last unfinished masterpiece.

ARNALDO POMODORO'S Labyrinth

In the underground spaces of the former Riva Calzoni building – now a Fendi Showroom – this underground labyrinth reflects the artist's inner turmoil.



PINK FLAMINGOS -Villa invernizzi

The Quadrilatero del Silenzio between Porta Venezia and Palestro is a quiet, secluded spot home to elegant *palazzi* with private gardens and pretty courtyards. Tucked away in a leafy garden behind Via Cappuccini 7 is a colony of pink flamingos that has lived here peacefully since the Seventies. Italian entrepreneur Romeo Invernizzi, who once resided in *Villa Invernizzi*, created a verdant oasis for these tall pink birds he imported from overseas. After his death, the birds continued to call the gardens their home, and have lived here ever since. The villa, which is closed to the public, is home to the *Fondazione Inverniz*zi, which supports projects in agriculture, economics and health.

Since 2017, a large urban canvas adorns the building that lies where *Largo la Foppa* and *Corso Garibaldi* meet. Renowned luxury brand Gucci works closely with pop artists, who regularly create eye-catching murals depicting the fashion house's latest promotional campaigns.

CRYPT OF SAN SEPOLCRO

Built on the site of the city's ancient Roman Forum, the *Crypt of San Sepolero* is the oldest underground church in Milan. Originally built in 1030 as a private chapel dedicated to the *Order of the Holy Sepulchre*, the crypt was erected where the Decumanus and the Cardo met, as depicted in one of Leonardo da Vinci's maps in the *Codex Atlanticus*. Reopened to the public after fifty years, the church has ancient Roman floors and is adorned with frescoes from the 14th century.

IL GIARDINO DELLE VERGINI

Hidden away in the ancient cloisters of the Università Cattolica del Sacro Cuore is a secret garden, the Giardino delle Vergini (Virgins' Garden). It was created in 1928 for Santa Caterina d'Alessandria, Christian saint, virgin and patron of studies. To this day, entry to this lush garden is permitted only to women.



GIARDINO PEREGO

THE CHESSBOARD OF SANT'AMBROGIO AND THE DEVIL'S COLUMN

Piazza Sant'Ambrogio, 15 +39.02.8645.0895basilicasantambrogio.it

The Basilica di Sant'Ambrogio is shrouded in mystery. On the left of the portico is the Colonna del Diavolo (Devil's Column) - legend says it was here that the demon stabbed Saint Ambrogio with his horns during a fight. At the top right of the Basilica's façade, a small chessboard was probably designed to keep evil spirits away, and may well recall the passage of the Templars, as suggested by a second large chessboard inside the church.





CASA 770 VIA POERIO

Via Carlo Poerio, 35

Steps away from Porta Venezia, at 35 Via Poerio, is Casa 770, a striking red-brick building with three gabled roofs that serves as a meeting point for the Milanese Jewish-Orthodox community. It's one of sixteen such constructions around the world, built to recall the building that Rabbi Rav Yoseph Yitzchak Schneerson purchased in Brooklyn when he moved to New York to escape Nazi persecution.



IL CORTILE DEGLI SCULTORI

Via Mac Mahon, 14

Among the modern buildings by the Monumental Cemetery is a nondescript 1960s block harbouring a lovely hidden courtyard. The "Cortile degli Scultori" (Sculptors' Courtyard) is lined with brick houses, former homes and workshops of stonemasons and stone carvers. Today, one shop remains, that of sculptor Mauro Baldessari. It's a peaceful, leafy spot that comes alive in spring, when banana trees, cherries and maple trees are in bloom.



CA' DE L'ORÈGGIA **VIA GABRIO SERBELLONI**

Via Gabrio Serbelloni, 10

The elegant Art Nouveau Palazzo Sola-Busca in Via Gabrio Serbelloni is known as Ca' de l'Orèggia, which translates as 'house of the ear' in Milanese dialect. The building has a bronze ear-shaped intercom created by Italian sculptor Adolfo Wildt. It is said that if you whisper a wish into the ear, it will come true.





IGLOO HOUSES IN THE JOURNALISTS' VILLAGE

Via Lepanto

North of the city lies the Villaggio dei Giornalisti (Journalists' Village), home to eight striking igloo-shaped houses built in the 40s. These unusual cement buildings, which also feature private gardens, are among the area's most distinctive sights, together with Villa Mirabello and the famous Casa Palafitta (House on Stilts).

IL CHIOSTRO DELLE UMILIATE

Via Cappuccio, 7

In the heart of the historic centre lies the Chiostro delle Umiliate, beautiful 15th century cloisters that are all that remains of the Monastery of Santa Maria Maddalena al Cerchio. Demolished by Napoleon in 1801, the building was subsequently bought and restored by Carla and Guido Ucelli. Today, it features a double arcade that opens onto a luxuriant garden with beautiful centuries-old plants that once adorned the monastery gardens.




