



Navy Budget for Fiscal Year 2023 (FY23)

1. TOPLINE \$180.5 BILLION

Operations & Maintenance – \$61.4 billion Procurement – \$53.8 billion Personnel – \$41.2 billion Research, Development, Test & Evaluation (RDT&E) – \$21 billion Military Construction – \$3.1 billion

2. RDT&E GETS LARGEST INCREASE

9.2% increase over Fiscal Year 2022 (enacted) FY22 (enacted) – \$19.3 billion

3. PERSONNEL GETS SMALLEST INCREASE

3.1% increase over Fiscal Year 2022 (enacted) FY22 (enacted) – \$39.9 billion

4. REQUESTS DECOMMISSIONING OF 24 SHIPS

Fifteen of those hulls to be kept in reserve status, making them eligible for reactivation. Nine of the ships moving to reserve status are Littoral Combat Ships.

5. UNFUNDED PRIORITIES LIST

\$4 billion Would raise Navy topline to \$184.5 billion.
