Integrity Matters in Getting Organized

- **Organize** resources and materials to complete the assignment (for example: articles to be used, PowerPoint slides, APA Manual, Academic Integrity resources)
- **Opt** to connect with the Chamberlain University Library for articles and materials, unless otherwise instructed. (Access to the Chamberlain University Library from the Resources tab in the course menu)
- **Outline** the content to be used in the assignment.



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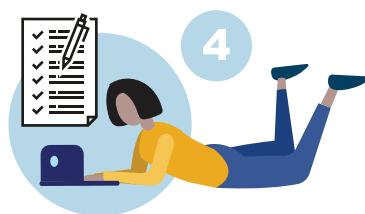


Integrity Matters in Writing and Citing

- **Cite** the information in your draft for easy referencing
- **Credit** all resources using APA format, unless otherwise instructed
- **Connect** with the Chamberlain University Library for writing resources (APA Academic Writer & APA Citation Tutorials)
- **Check** your spelling and grammar using Grammarly before submitting your assignment (Grammarly is free and is located in the Resources tab of your course)

Integrity Matters in Completing and Checking

- **Compose/construct** the assignment
- **Check** the guidelines again to ensure all information is included
- **Confirm** the rubric information has been addressed
- **Complete** the assignment submission process as directed
